# **Holiday Campground Rules**

#### **Campers**

- Please obey the park speed limit of 5 1/2 mph! Children don't watch for you! You have to watch out for them!
- Keep your car tag displayed on your rearview mirror at all times.
- Quiet hours are 11pm until 8pm. Please be considerate of your fellow campers.

### Pets

- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 6' at all times.
- Pets are not allowed in any park buildings, the pool enclosure, or the playground.
- Visitors may not bring pets into the park.
- Pets must be picked up after everywhere in the park, including in the nature trails and wooded areas!
- Please do not allow children under 12 years of age to walk a pet without an adult.

### **Campfires**

- Do not move fire rings.
- Do not burn trash in fire rings.
- All fires must be fully extinguished by 12am.
- Do not leave campfires unattended.
- Do not cut our trees! It will result in ejection from the park. Do not drive nails into or hang items from trees.

# <u>Children</u>

- Parents are responsible for the actions of their children.
- Children 14 and under are not allowed in the Pool area, Recreation Center, or at any water feature, including the ponds, creek, & river without adult supervision. Must be 18 years of age to provide adult supervision.
- Do not allow children under the age of 7 to go to the bath house unsupervised.
- All children must return to their sites by 10pm.

#### **Golf Carts**

- Golf carts must have proof of current insurance to be operated in the park.
- Golf carts may only be operated by a licensed driver over the age of 16.
- Golf carts must have headlights to be operated in the park after dark.
- Visitors to your site may not bring a golf cart into the park.

The guest assumes all risks and danger incidental to the activity of camping in a rustic outdoors environment, including specifically (but not exclusively), the danger of being injured by insects or other animals, of being injured while participating in recreational activities such as planned activities, hiking, swimming, use of playground and other recreational equipment, or fishing at the Camp Resort, or of being injured as a result of inclement weather conditions and agrees that the Camp Resort and its owners, agents, and employees are not liable for injuries or property damage resulting from such cases.

# **Visitors**

- Because we are at facility capacity on Holiday
  Weekends, there is a limit of 8 people that may be on a site at any given time. This includes any visitors to your site.
- Any visitors that arrive when the maximum number of people are on already on your site will be turned away. Please make arrangements accordingly.
- All visitors must check in at the Ranger Station and pay the guest fees of \$3 per person for anyone over the age of 3.
- To limit traffic in the park, all guests must park in the field at the front of the park and walk to your site. Accommodations will be made for those with special needs.
- Any visitor that does not register in the front office will be asked to leave the park. No exceptions.
- Any vehicle not displaying the proper tag in their window may be towed at the owner's expense.
- Visitors to your site may not bring pets into the park.
- Visitors may not bring a golf cart into the park.
- Visitors may not enter the park before 9am and must leave the park by 10pm.
- Registered Campers are responsible for their Visitor's behavior and actions.

#### Alcoholic Beverages

- Alcoholic beverages are allowed on your site only.
- Do not take alcoholic beverages into the pool area, game room, or around any of the water features.
- Drunken and unruly conduct will not be tolerated.
- Illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. Law enforcement will be called if necessary.

#### Bicycles, Skateboards, & Scooters

- Bicycles, skate boards, & scooters may be operated on the roads and paths only.
- Do not take bicycles, skateboards, & scooters into any of the park buildings or the pavilion.
- Do not take bicycles, skate boards, & scooters onto the playground.
- Do not ride bicycles or scooters after dark without headlights.
- Please Place all Trash in Dumpsters.
- No alcohol off your site.
- No food, alcohol, or smoking in the pool area.
- Swim diapers are required for anyone who is incontinent or not fully potty trained.
- No street clothes may be worn into the pool. Bathing suits and Rash Guard only.
- Children under 5 must be accompanied by an adult to all park events.
